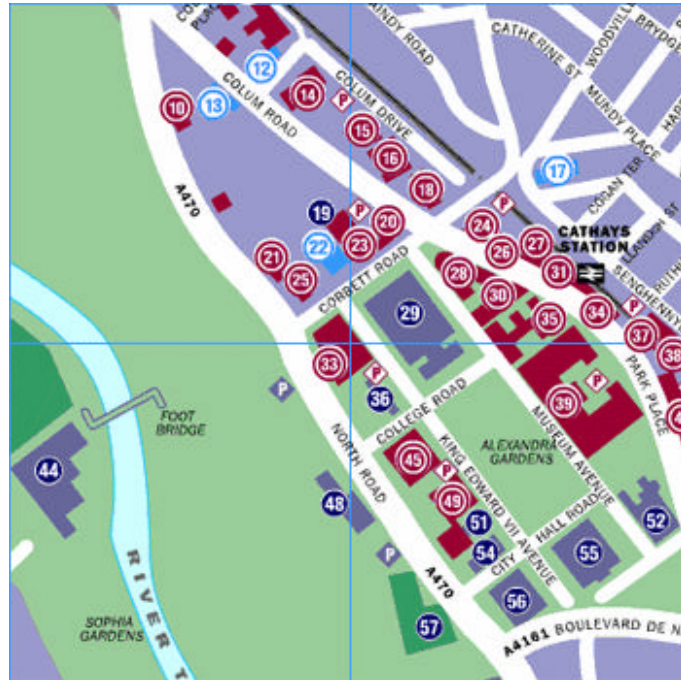

Dr Barry Morgan has been Bishop of Llandaff since 1999 and Archbishop of Wales since 2003 having previously served as Bishop of Bangor 1993-99. Born in Neath, South Wales, he read history at London, Theology at Cambridge and trained for the ministry at Wescott House, Cambridge. He studied for a doctorate whilst a university lecturer. He is also currently Pro-Chancellor of the University of Wales, a fellow of Cardiff, UWIC, Bangor and Lampeter and President of the Welsh Centre for International Affairs and has just chaired an inquiry on behalf of Shelter Cymru on homelessness in Wales. Since 2004, he has been Chair of Cymru Yfory – Tomorrow's Wales, a cross-party, cross-sector movement that campaigns for the furthering of devolution and democracy in Wales and works to encourage civic engagement with the National Assembly.
